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Equifest of Kansas Ranch Rodeo Rules

GENERAL RULES:

1. All contestants must wear cowboy hats, boots and long sleeve shirts while in the arena. Chaps are preferred but not mandatory.
2. All ranch teams will consist of four cowboys.
3. Any intentional tripping or undue roughness with stock or equipment may result in disqualification at any time in any event.
4. When roping, animals must be taken into control immediately. Any attempt to advance the animal toward the time line will result in disqualification.
5. Ranch teams should leave the arena as soon as the event is complete.
6. If, at the completion of a run there is a rope on the animal, it will be retrieved in the catch pen.
7. The next team must be ready to enter the arena following completion of the previous run.
8. Each team is responsible for its team members and their actions.
9. Any mistakes not the team's fault will be re-run.
10. Any changes will be announced prior to the rodeo.
11. Cattle must be handled like they will be marketed that day.
12. No alcoholic beverages allowed in the team holding areas.
13. All teams must agree to cheerfully follow the policies and the rules of the event.
14. No tying on in an event.
15. Cowboy must take rope with him when dismounting in any event where roping is involved.
16. Legal catches are neck, or neck and one front leg. Figure 8 is allowed.

TEAM SORTING Official Rules:

1. Team sorts three designated cattle within a two-minute limit.
2. Time starts when a team member crosses the chalk line. At that time, the team will be given a number designating the cattle. Any or all members may cross the chalk line.
3. Any undesignated steer that crosses the chalk line will receive a NO TIME.
4. The team will receive a NO TIME if any designated cattle re-cross or come back over the chalk line.
5. The time will be called when the tail of the last steer crosses the line. A NO TIME will be given for less than 3 cattle.

SINGLE MUGGING Official Rules:

1. Four-man team, all on horseback.
2. One steer will be turned out and roped within 45 seconds.
3. After a steer is roped, cowboy dismounts and ties 3 legs together and removes the loop. Animal must stay tied for 6 seconds.
4. Steer must be mugged down.
5. Two-minute time limit.

TRAILER LOADING Official Rules:

1. Time starts with flag.
2. Trailer gate must be shut when time starts.
3. Cow/steer must be caught within 45 seconds.
4. Cow/steer must be loaded by hand into trailer.
5. Door on trailer must be shut, latched, and all team members must be out of the trailer and in the circle before time is called. Rope must be clear of the trailer.
6. Trailer will remain stationary at all time during this event. Time stops with the flag.
7. Two-minute time limit.

WILD COW MILKING Official Rules:

1. Four-man team; anyone may rope; roper who catches cow must milk the cow.
2. Cow will be at end of arena; cowboys will be at opposite end.
3. When flag drops, cowboys may start.
4. Cow must be caught within 30 seconds. Rope must pass over cow's head.
5. Muggers dismount and mug the cow; rope must be on the ground before the cow is milked. Cow must be on her feet. After milking, anyone may run on foot with the bottle in hand to the circle to stop the time and must hand the bottle to the judge for inspection.
6. Judge must pour milk and there must be at least a "drop" out of the bottle to receive time.
7. One and one-half minutes (90 seconds) time limit.

RULES MEETING:

1. Each team must have a representative present during the Rules Meeting located in Ag Hall, (Indoor Warm Up Arena).
2. Rules meeting will start at 6:15pm before each 7:00 pm performance.
3. Any changes, additions or amendments to the rules will be announced at the rules meeting. Those changes will supersede any rules published or otherwise implied.
